Personal data that we process

Rimor Brewery processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide them to us yourself.

Below is an overview of the personal data that we process:

- First and last name
- E-mail address
- Location data
- Information about your activities on our website
- Data about your surfing behaviour across different websites (for example, because this company is part of an advertising network)
- Internet browser and device type

Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are under 16 years of age. Unless they have permission from parents or a guardian. However, we cannot verify whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore recommend that parents are involved in their children's online activities to avoid collecting data about children without parental consent. For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

Rimor Brewery processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Sending our newsletter and/or advertising brochure.
- Rimor Brewery analyses your behaviour on the website in order to improve the website and tailor the offer of products and services to your preferences.
- Rimor Brewery also processes personal data if we are legally obliged to do so, such as data we need for our tax return.

How long we keep personal data

Rimor Brewery does not retain your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to fulfil the purposes for which your data is collected. When it is no longer necessary to keep your personal data we will securely delete it.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Rimor Brewery does not sell your data to third parties and only provides it if it is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We conclude a processor agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Rimor Brewery remains responsible for this processing.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Rimor Brewery uses analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone the first time you visit this website. Rimor Brewery places cookies that track your browsing behaviour so that we can offer customized content and advertising.

During your first visit to our website, we have already informed you about these cookies and asked your permission to place them.

You can opt out of cookies by setting your Internet browser to no longer store cookies. In addition, you can also delete any information previously stored through your browser settings.

Accessing, modifying or deleting data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You can do this yourself via the personal settings of your account. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your possible consent to data processing or object to the processing of your personal data by our company and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organization named by you.

If you wish to exercise your right of objection and/or right to data portability, or if you have other questions/comments about data processing, please send an itemized request to info@rimor.be.

To make sure that the request for inspection is made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the request. In this copy, black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip of numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy. Rimor Brewery will respond to your request as soon as possible, but in any case, within four weeks.

Rimor Brewery would also like to inform you that you have the possibility of submitting a complaint to the national supervisory authority, the Personal Data Authority. You can do so via the following link: [Netherlands](#) and [Belgium](#).

You have the following rights:

- Explaining what personal data we have about you and how we use it.
- To have the personal data we have about you corrected.
- To have outdated personal data we hold about you deleted.
- Withdrawing consent to use your personal data.
- Objecting to a particular use of your personal data.
- Be sure to clearly identify who you are so we can be sure we are not modifying or deleting data belonging to the wrong person.
